Schedule

Each round begins at 5:00pm, with the exception of the final day, Sunday, July 08, 2018, on which the round begins at 10:00am.

The award ceremony will be held on Sunday, July 08, 2018 at approximately 4:00pm.

Format

The tournament is a 9-round Swiss system. The time control is 90 minutes for the first 40 moves followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Any player arriving later than 30 minutes after the official start of the round will forfeit his/her game.

The tournament is subject to the FIDE Laws of Chess which went into effect on January 1, 2018. Tournament results will be Elo- and DWZ-rated.

Rating prizes are guaranteed assuming at least 70 participants.

The final distribution will be determined by the tournament direction in order to form three rating groups of approximately equal size.

Special prizes (will be announced at the start of the tournament): for women, seniors (60 years and older) and youth (up to 18 years).

Free drinks will be awarded for exceptional tournament performance.

Awarding of Prizes

A maximum of one prize per participant will be awarded.

The primary prizes will be awarded according to the Hort System. In the event of tied scores, tiebreaks will be determined as follows: the Buchholz score (excluding the opponent with the fewest points), then the number of wins, then the Sonneborn-Berger score and finally by lottery.

Winnings of foreign players exempt from German taxes are subject to the German income tax code §50a.
